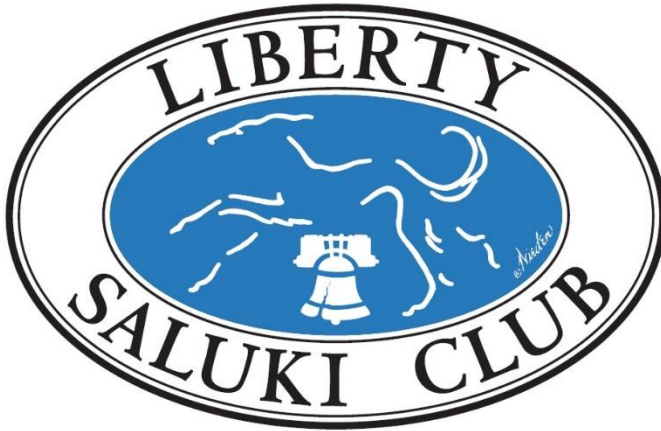

- There are no parking fees. In addition, there is NO overnight parking allowed. The showground will be available for access at 7:00 a.m. on Sunday, October 10, 2021.
- Cars, vans, SUVs, and RVs should park so as to allow a practical amount of space to provide for social distancing.
- There are NO hookups for RVs.
- Grooming will be available under cover, with electricity provided for grooming ONLY (no vehicle hookups).
- Electricity is not available on the site, nor are there sewer hookups.
- Exceptions are at the discretion of the Show Chairperson.
- This is a self clean-up site. You are required to take care of your business.
- Smoking is not permitted under the ring tent nor under the covered grooming area.
- The health, safety, and life of any dog on the grounds is paramount to other property and privacy rights. All vehicle owners on the grounds waive their right to legal actions or damages should it be necessary to rescue dogs from the confines of an overheated vehicle.
- After you have completed showing, please exit the show area to support COVID social distancing guidelines.

DIRECTIONS:

Montgomery County Farm, Home & 4-H Center is located on Route 113 between Route 73 and Route 29 in Skippack. With easy access from Routes 422 and 63, and close to the Northeast Extension of the Pennsylvania Turnpike (Lansdale exit).

From I-476 Northeast Extension of Pennsylvania Turnpike: Take Lansdale exit. Make a left at the light (Rt. 63/Sumneytown Pike). In 0.3 miles turn right on Bustard Road. Continue about 1.5 miles to Route 73. Turn right on Route 73, go about two miles to Route 113. Turn left on Route 113. Montgomery County 4H center is one mile on the right (about 15 minutes from exit to show site).

- **ENTRIES CLOSE AT THE SUPERINTENDENT/SHOW SECRETARY'S OFFICE**, by 7:00pm on Wednesday, September 22, 2021 after which time entries cannot be accepted, altered, canceled, or substituted.
- **ENTRY FORM MUST BE SIGNED** at the bottom by the owner or the owner's duly authorized agent, otherwise the entry cannot be accepted. Telegraph or telephone entries cannot be accepted. **OVERNIGHT deliveries** requiring **NO** signature only. Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.
- **MAKE ALL CHECKS & money orders payable to Erie Canine Event Services (ECES)**
- **RETURNED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check.
- **OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE** for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. PLEASE TYPE OR PRINT carefully, the information on entry forms to eliminate errors. There are PDF fillable forms on the Erie website!
- **A RECORDING FEE OF \$50** is to be collected **on the first entry only for each dog, each day. An Event Service fee of \$3.00** will be required for each regular class each dog is entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial, Rally Trial or Tracking Test. These Fees are to be collected by the show giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. (AKC Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2).... Included in the entry fee.
- **NO ENTRY FEES** will be returned if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the management. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from the competition by action of the Show Committee.

- **DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING.** The Club or Show Secretary will not be responsible and is not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owner or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.
- **DOGS MAY ARRIVE ANY TIME PRIOR** to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. All dogs present must be held on leash in hand except when being judged.
- **NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE** and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.
- **NO REFUND ON DUPLICATE ENTRIES.** Every effort will be made to find duplicate entries, but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.
- **THE SHOW-GIVING CLUB, THE SHOW SECRETARY,** their agents and employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury, sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children not under the control of their parents or guardians.
- **WHEN THE SAME DOG IS ENTERED** in more than one class, only the highest score will be used for the top awards in Trial or top awards of a breed.
- **ALL AWARDS MUST BE CLAIMED** at the Trial or they become the property of the Irish Setter Club of Ohio. None will be mailed.
- **ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE HELD ON LEASH** or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercise ring. All handlers are asked to clean up after their own dog.
- **CLASS CASH PRIZES** will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog.
- **CLAIMS FOR PRIZE MONEY** must be made in the ring before the judging of that class is over and Show Secretary advised at once. The show secretary and show-giving club may disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the class is over. **NO PRIZES WILL BE MAILED.**

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

- 1 (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- 2 The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3 (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- 4 A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
