### NON-REGULAR CLASSES: Multiple Dog Entries (NATIONALS ONLY)

**These classes are not eligible for Best of Breed**

**Stud Dog Class** - For Stud Dogs and at least two but no more than five of his Get.

**Brood Bitch Class** - For brood bitch and at least two but no more than five of her produce.

**Stud Dog Class and Brood Bitch Class:** Each entry is allowed two to five get. The merits of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch are not considered in the placement of the entry. It is the quality of the get that forms the basis for the judge's decision. All get must be examined and gaited. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must also be examined to determine if there is a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Rules, AKC policy or the breed standard. All get must be entered in a regular class (or Best of Breed) in order to be eligible to compete in the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch Class. Handlers of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch, and all get being exhibited, must wear armbands. Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog ... and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch."

**NOTE FOR BOTH:** The Stud Dog/Brood Bitch may be entered separately in regular classes not of a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition at the regular entry fee of \$ 35.00 with Stud Dog/Brood Bitch Class indicated on the entry form in the space for "Additional Classes" with the additional fee of \$ 26.00. The Get/Produce MUST be entered and shown individually in one of the regular classes or Best of Breed Competition. There is no additional entry fee for the Get/Produce as participants with their Stud Dog/Brood Bitch.

#### RV Parking Notes:

All RV electric service connections necessitate parking on an asphalt parking platform immediately adjacent to the training building.

- The charge for each 20-amp electric service connections is \$10 per night.
- Use of air conditioners is prohibited for RVs using any of the 4 electric service connections.
- **No water or sanitary sewer service connections** are available for RVs anywhere at the KKCTF.
- The Kalamazoo KC will be using their training facility through the evening of Wednesday, September 29 with clean-up to follow, so access to the site will be limited from Wednesday 4-7pm and not available until the morning of Thursday, September 30, 2021.
- The KKCTF does have a grassy area with compacted gravel base suitable for RV parking. That area appears to be large enough to accommodate those of you who can and desire to “make do” without any utility service connections and is available to GWPCA members “free-of-charge” during the 2021 Nationals gathering.
