ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES will not be accepted.. **ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRIES** will be made as soon as practicable with tickets &/or identification cards. ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS AND PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS, without the Agreement & Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund shall be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors, & spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors, & spectators is of paramount importance, and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

THE SHOW COMMITTEE / SUPERINTENDENT will use due care & diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club and the Superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards, or runners, for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

Dogs need not be at the show until their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the x-pens.

CANINE COURTESY All dogs shall be kept under control at all times. You are responsible for picking up after the animals in your care.

PLEASE RESPECT OUR HOSTING SITE! EXERCISE DOGS IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY There will be pooper scoopers and containers on the grounds. PLEASE USE THEM.

GASOLINE OR DIESEL GENERATORS are NOT permitted.

REFUNDS IF made will be in the same system as the original payment. Either by check, if check was mailed or by PayPal if entry was done on-line. Erie does not, at this time, charge an administrative fee for entries cancelled prior to close of show. **Effective January 1, 2009** Refund & Cash award checks are void after 180 days and will NOT be re-issued.

NOVICE CLASS: Is for dogs that have not previously won 3 first places in Novice Class, a 1st place in Amateur-Owner-Handler, Bred-by-Exhibitor, American-bred, or Open Classes or who have not earned one or more points toward their championship.

AMATEUR OWNER HANDLED CLASS: Is for dogs handled by the registered owner who has not, at any point, been a professional dog handler, an AKC approved conformation judge or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. [NOTE: This is a regular class and has nothing to do with the National Owner Handler Series. A dog that wins this class is eligible to compete for Winners Dog or Bitch just like any other class.]

BEST OF BREED (VARIETY) COMPETITION: *The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed champions in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship. Selects, if applicable, will be chosen following Best of Breed*

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FOUR-TO-SIX MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY COMPETITION

The Four-to-Six Month Beginner Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and under six months on the day of the event.

Classes will not be divided by sex in this competition.

AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Ch. 3, Sec. 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows

A Foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin. • FSS Number of FSS Registered litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and FSS Breed Entries. •

All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol. •

Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler.

Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend.

Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition

No dog is to be judged if it is brought into the ring bandaged, taped, glued or stitched anywhere including ears or tail. These dogs must be excused from judging but, at the judge's discretion, may return to be judged after the tape or bandage is removed

Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition.

All applicable rules found in Rules Applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise.
